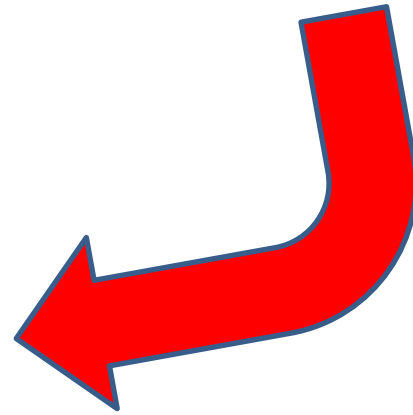

The Challenge of Change Managing landscapes for the future

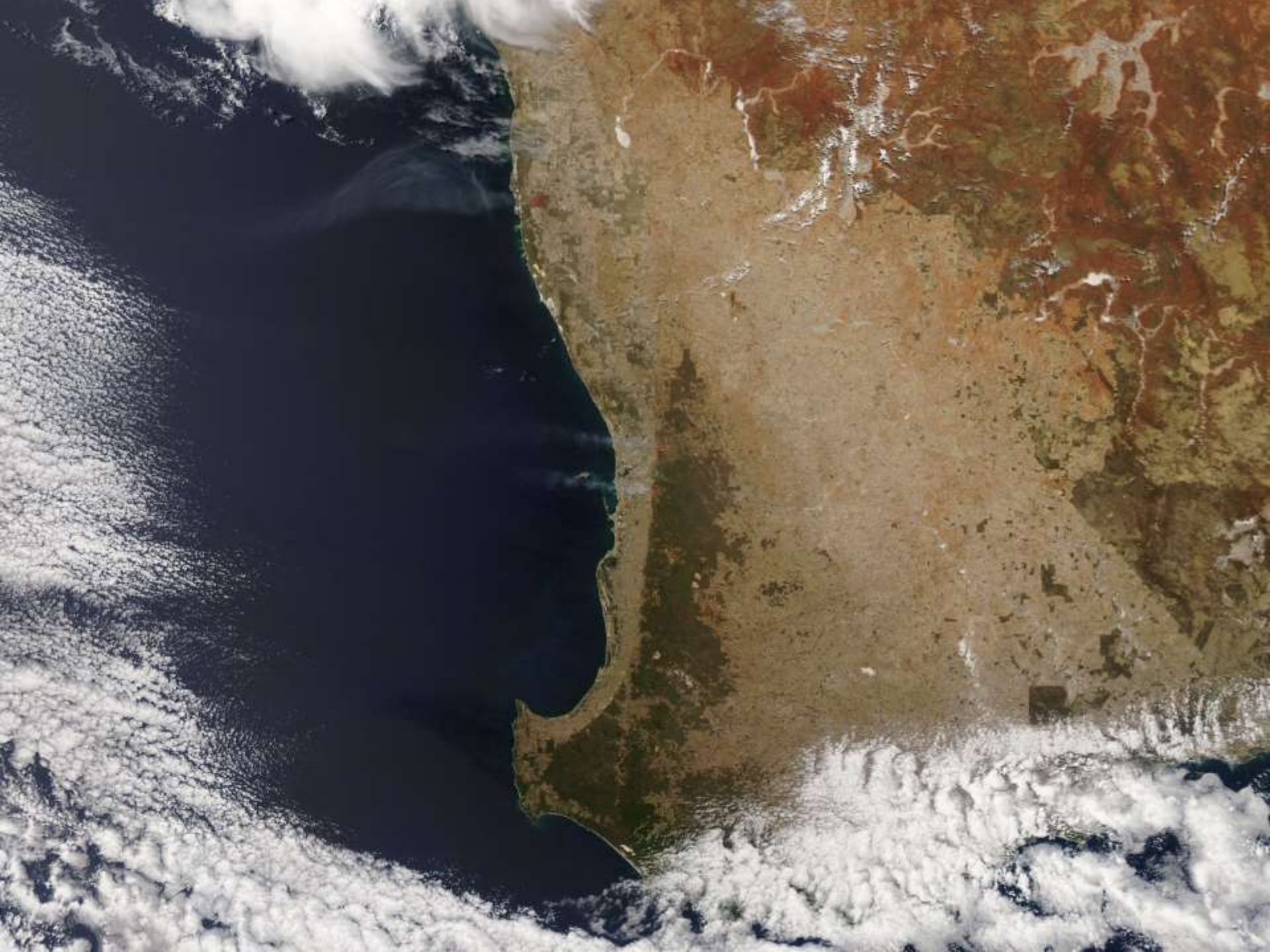


