Research based Projects

- **Murdoch University** – Microbats play an important part in terrestrial biodiversity, this research will provide data on the health of the microbat populations
- **Carbon Neutral** – How do our revegetation sites compare with remnant vegetations in providing ecosystem functions and biodiversity of invertebrate communities, the largest class of organism on earth, such as ants, spiders, beetles, native cockroaches, centipedes and scorpions
- **Yarra Yarra Catchment Management Group** – Reptiles and small mammals are excellent indicators of revegetation quality, this research will identify effective revegetation strategies to provide habitat for these animals in the Gundduwa region

Research & Training Projects

- **Conservation Council WA** – Training workshops for volunteers for bird monitoring on the conservation stations
- **Northern Agricultural Catchments Council** – Badimaya Ranger Program training on country for conservation outcomes
